**If you have unused vacation time (below the maximum amount allowed)** these hours will rollover on December 31, 2017 for you to use in 2018. This will be the last time that unused vacation hours will rollover from one year to the next.

Friendly reminder, the day after Thanksgiving is no longer a designated holiday for Goodwill. If you would normally be scheduled to work on a Friday, please report to work as usual.
